**Ash Road Bridge – upcoming investigation work
From Friday 13 August for approximately two weeks**

I am writing to let you know about ground investigation work that will be taking place in fields to the north and south of the railway line near Ash Station.

The work involves digging a number of holes using specialist machinery to identify and investigate ground conditions. These investigations are in preparation for the design and construction of the road bridge which will connect Guildford Road/Ash Hill Road Roundabout to a new junction with Foreman Road over the North Downs Railway line south of the existing Ash level crossing.

The work is planned to start at around 9am on Friday 13 August 2021 and be completed by Friday 20 August 2021. Working hours for each day will be 8am-5pm.

Ground investigation work will also be taking place on Foreman Park for one day on Wednesday 18 August and on Foreman Road for two days on the Thursday 19 and Friday 20 August. A traffic light system will be in place on those days to allow traffic to continue to use Foreman Road, create a safe working area for the project and walking routes for pedestrians.
